Submit at Manuscript central as Cloud of Things 2017 special issue. Submissions should be prepared for publication according to the journal submission guidelines. If the submitted journal paper is from the BWCCA 2017 conference, it **must** have at least 50% difference from any other published paper.

The submitted papers must be original and must not be under consideration in any other venue. All submitted papers will be reviewed by at least three reviewers.
